This letter serves as formal notification and official record of action taken by the Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities (NWCCU) at its meeting on June 18-21, 2024, concerning the Spring 2024 Financial Resources Review of Warner Pacific University.

Accreditation

Accept the Report, Issue a Sanction of Warning on Recommendation 2: Spring 2020 Evaluation of Institutional Effectiveness

Status of Previous Recommendations Addressed in this Evaluation

- Recommendation 2: Spring 2020 Evaluation of Institutional Effectiveness - Continued as Non-Compliant

Recommendations Out of Compliance

The Commission finds that the following Recommendations are areas where Warner Pacific University is out of compliance with the NWCCU Standards for Accreditation. According to U.S. Department of Education Regulation 34 CFR 602.20 and Commission Policy, the Commission requires that Warner Pacific University take appropriate action to ensure these Recommendations are addressed and resolved within the prescribed four-year period.

The Commission recommends that Warner Pacific University:

- Recommendation 2: Spring 2020 Evaluation of Institutional Effectiveness - Demonstrate short and long-term financial health and stability by strategically growing enrollment, controlling expenses, and becoming less dependent on unrestricted giving to cover operating deficits. (2020 Standard(s) 2.E.1;2.E.2)
