- Major/Core Cohort at WPU (50 semester credits), grades of C- or higher
- Successful competition of 15 weeks of student teaching (ED 495)

Candidates will need to meet all Oregon Teacher Standards and Practices Commission (TSPC) requirements for licensure, including successful submission of an edTPA to Pearson for evaluation and passing the ORELA subject matter exams.
