1. Complete 78 transferrable quarter credits at Mt. Hood Community College

- You may select any area of study at Mt Hood Community College, but should include the general education core courses listed in the table below.
- > The Early Childhood Education curriculum and the Education curriculum at Mt. Hood Community provides an excellent foundation for students interested in this area of study.
- > The following courses (grades C- or higher) should be completed and will transfer to WPU to meet the lower-division general education core requirements:

These courses are optional but encouraged at Mt Hood Community College. If completed for transfer, they will apply towards the BS in Early Childhood/Elementary Education Curriculum requirements at WPU.

2. Complete the BS in Early Childhood/Elementary Education Curriculum at WPU (68 credits)

The BS in Early Childhood/Elementary Education curriculum includes 18 baccalaureate major courses and 3 advanced-level GE core courses (a total of 21 courses/68 semester credits at the baccalaureate level).

- > The courses are designed to build on your professional experience and prior coursework in order to deepen your theoretical knowledge and to be professionally useful and engaging.
- If you are lacking any of the transfer courses from the table above, your advisor at WPU will assist with scheduling replacement courses. This may increase the number of courses/credits that you will complete at WPU.
